Meeting called to order by MVCC President Suzanne Riggenbach at 7:04 p.m.

Minutes

The meetings from the May 16 meeting were read by Secretary Lisa Gray and approved. (There was no meeting in June, just the annual potluck.)

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Mark Clemmons presented the report.

As of June 30, MVCC checking account had \$7,501.07. Money market account, \$5,995.88. Pay Pal account, \$1,310.15. Total assets, \$14,807.10.

The report was appoved.

HPD Liaison

HPD Officer Jerry Rodriguez reported that in Meadowcreek had one burglary and three in June. (Thefts tend to go up when school is out.) One robbery was reported. Overall, he said, it's "pretty good."

State Representative's Liaison

Sara Montelongo, a staff member for state Rep. Carol Alvarado, reported that Alvarado will deliver a State of the District address after the Legislative session is over. The representative is sponsoring a health week in September, and a diabetes-awareness initiative in November.

Legislative Update

Elizabeth Perez is looking into a long list of initiatives: petitions to put road humps on major thoroughfares through the neighborhood, to stop drag racing; a 380 tax-rebate agreement with the city to attract a business to the old bowling alley near Meadowcreek; and sidewalks for Highway 3/Old Galveston Road so that students walking to school won't be risking their lives.

Old Business

Signs: The civic club has ordered a new vertical banner, 5' tall.

Mark Clemmons and Greg Brown are looking for volunteers to help move the MVCC sign near Elim Church.

Mark Clemmons reported that 16 new aluminum signs, identifying Meadowcreek Village as "a deed-restricted neighborhood," and giving the website's address, will be placed on light poles around the neighborhood.

Another new sign will announce the civic club's meeting date and time.

Six Texas Night Out signs should be ordered for October.

The total for all the new signs will be between \$500 and \$600.

Texas Night Out: Volunteers are needed to host parties or help with events in October.

Election of new MVCC officers: Will take place at the October meeting.

The St. Augustine church bazaar: MVCC will have a booth there on October 5.
