Texas Law for Motorists and School Buses

Texas law requires approaching drivers to stop when a school bus is stopped and operating a visual signal (red flashing lights or a stop sign). Drivers should not proceed until the bus resumes motion; the driver is signaled by the bus driver to proceed; or the visual signal is no longer activated.

A driver does not have to stop for a school bus if it is on a highway with roadways separated by an intervening space or physical barrier. For example: **Allendale Rd.** If a highway is divided only by a left-turning lane and the roadways are not separated, drivers must stop for school buses.

Drivers who do not stop for school buses face a fine of up to \$1,000. If a driver is convicted of this offense more than one time, DPS can suspend their license for up to six months.
