# How Do We Keep the Neighborhood BEAUTIFUL?

Our Best Tools are to Follow the RULES!

Almost everyone enjoys living in a nice, safe neighborhood. We all work hard everyday, and enjoy coming home to relax and spend time with our family, friends, and pets. The ABSOLUTE BEST WAY for us to keep our neighborhood safe and beautiful is to simply FOLLOW THE RULES! Here is a **TOP FIVE** list to help us all remember what the rules are to keep our neighborhood looking BEAUTIFUL!

- 1. You cannot put your HEAVY TRASH out in front of your house until THE FRIDAY BEFORE IT IS TO BE PICKED UP. This includes building materials, furniture, mattresses, TVs, and general trash. This is a Civic Club and City of Houston Rule!
- 2. You cannot park motor vehicles in your yard. This is a Civic Club and City of Houston rule.
- 3. You can only put your trash cans out ONE DAY before the scheduled pickup. Once the can has been picked up you cannot leave it out in your yard. The trash cans must be put away out of sight. This is a Civic Club Deed Restriction rule
- 4. You cannot let your yard become overgrown with grass and weeds. This is a Civic Club Deed Restriction rule and City of Houston Rule.
- 5. You cannot have inoperable vehicles parked (within plain view of the street) on your property, or on street in front of your home. This is a Meadowcreek Civic Club Deed Restriction rule and a City of Houston rule.

The Meadowcreek Civic Club and the City of Houston will have inspectors driving around to make sure everyone is following the rules and keeping our neighborhood BEAU-TIFUL. Keep this in mind: *Nobody is out snitching on you, and Nobody is trying to be bossy with you*. We are all trying to keep our neighborhood and our property values moving on up! Nobody likes to get into trouble....so remember: "You won't pay a fine, if you take a little time.... and FOLLOW THE RULES!

November - 11th, 25th

December - 9th, 23rd

## **Heavy Trash**

JUNK WASTE - Mattresses TVs, Furniture, Construction waste, Metal objects.

**OCTOBER, DECEMBER 2019** 

**TREE WASTE** - Tree Limbs, Bushes, Brush **SEPTEMBER, NOVEMBER 2019** 

If you live north of Allendale, pickup will be the FIRST MONDAY of the month
If you live south of Allendale pickup will be the SECOND MONDAY of the month

Remember to only put your Trash Bins or Heavy Trash out the day before they are due to be picked up. *JUNK WASTE is especially important* to *NOT put out until the Friday before pickup*. If your scheduled trash pickup does NOT come (sometimes they are very late), you can *call 311* and report your issue.
